New for the 2017-2018 school year

- Membership Fee is \$50 for the school year (Aug thru May).
- \$25 for each session. (August/December is Fall Session- January through May Is Spring Session)
- If you would like to bring a guest, they must fill out the waiver form, and it **must** be signed by a parent/guardian prior to their visit. You may bring one guest per month for free. Each guest after is \$5 per visit.
- FREE Teen Express service is available for members of the HYDE Out only. It is on a first come, first serve basis and you must register **prior** to using the service.

Teens must have all paperwork completed, in order to utilize The HYDE Out.

Be aware that **photos may be taken** of this program for publication in our recreation guide, Facebook page, website and/or other promotional use. Please note on your Waiver Form if you object to photos being used.

Scope of the program

The HYDE Out is a place for teens to hang out and socialize in a safe environment during after school hours. A structured list of activities will be posted weekly in addition to our game room. There is a pool table, air hockey, table tennis, foosball PlayStation 3 gaming console and board games that can be utilized. A homework station is provided equipped with school supplies and The HYDE Out Staff is available for help. Throughout the year, The HYDE Out will host many activities, events and gatherings including craft projects, gaming tournaments, community service projects, and volunteering. We also have a Teen Advisory Board in which students can help mold The HYDE Out into their own while learning leadership and organization skills that will help them in the future.

Program Rules

- Sign in when arriving and sign out before leaving the HYDE Out
- YOU are responsible for you own property. We are not responsible for lost, damaged, or stolen belongings including electronics.
- Respect the HYDE Out staff, facility and equipment.
- Inappropriate physical contact and profanity will not be tolerated.
- All participants need a CRPD waiver on file.

Program Hours

- The HYDE Out is open Monday - Friday from 3pm to 6pm. We are open on early release days and super minimum days throughout the school year.
- The HYDE Out follows the FCUSD calendar. We will be closed on days that this school district is closed. The HYDE Out may also close for staff in-service trainings as well as unforeseen circumstances such as a power outage. Please check our Facebook page and the CRPD web page for details on closures.

- **CRPD is not responsible for participants after the center closes at 6pm. Transportation/ plan for travel home should be pre-arranged with your child so no participant is left after closing.**

Behavioral Policies

Inappropriate behavior will be addressed promptly. The situation will be discussed by the staff and the participant(s) involved. The parent(s) of the participant may be contacted. The following format is used:

- 1st offense Warning
- 2nd offense Parent will be contacted and participant will be removed from the center.
- 3rd offense Parent will be contacted and participant will be suspended from the program for the remainder of the school year.

Consequences may include a suspension from HYDE Out activities and special events. If the participant is a danger to themselves or others, or is interfering with the program, the parent/guardian will be asked to pick him/her up from the facility immediately.

Physical aggression or violence is addressed as follows:

- 1st offense Removal from activity. If uncooperative, violent or disrespectful of staff, parent will be contacted and participant will need to be picked up immediately.
- 2nd offense Suspended from The HYDE Out.
- 3rd offense Permanent removal from program.

Frequently Asked Questions

- **Do you take registration on-line for this program?**

Yes, you may register online at www.crpdc.com and download the registration packet to turn in when you arrive at The HYDE Out.

- **What activities can they participate in at The HYDE Out?**

The center provides homework help, various recreational activities and crafts daily. There is also an air hockey, foosball, table tennis and pool table available for use. The HYDE Out also hosts a variety of special events and get-togethers throughout the school year as well as seasonal camps during winter, spring and summer.

- **What are the staff qualifications and how are they trained?**

Staff is certified in both CPR & First-Aid; they must pass a background check and are trained in games, leadership and how to work with youth and teens. Staff is hired based on their experience with ages 12-15 and are at least 18 years or older.

- **Should I call if my son/daughter will be attending The HYDE Out after school?**

Calling ahead is not necessary. As long as the teen has membership forms on file, they are welcome to drop in during operating hours, which are after school (including minimum days and early release days) until 6PM.

Days and Times: Monday – Friday after school to 6pm

The Cordova Recreation and Park District's The HYDE Out teen center is based at the Hagan Community Center. Planned activities make extensive use of Hagan Community Park. Wildlife does flourish in these vicinities. Gophers, poisonous and non-poisonous snakes and skunks have all been encountered by park users. Bee stings do occur, however infrequently.

Arts and Crafts activities involve paints, pastes, glues, paper, scissors, crayons, other basic materials, and items found by participants. Active games are conducted on turf, asphalt, concrete and unimproved exterior surfaces; while indoor activities of active and passive types are held on tiled and hardwood floors. Games engaged in by participants may involve balls, bats, frisbees and hula hoops; they may require running, skipping, sliding and jumping.

Quite often there are other activities taking place in the surrounding areas during the conduct of The HYDE Out activities. Some of these activities are sponsored by CRPD, some by other agencies and many are unscheduled and spontaneous use of the area by groups and individuals. The District maintenance activities such as mowing, watering, trimming, repairing and cleaning are ongoing.

Parents of children who take medication during the program assume all responsibility and risk of that medication. District will not be held responsible for injuries or problems that occur due to the use of medication. The District is not responsible for medication which is lost, stolen or traded by children. Problems may include: overdose, child refusing to take medication or injuries to a child who receives medication prescribed to another child. District staff will not administer medication or assist child in taking medication. The District will not be held responsible if child forgets or refuses to take medication.

Please be advised that the District places the highest priority on the safety of all participants. Staff is well trained and staff-participant ratios are lower than many comparable programs. However, with activities taking place out-of-doors, over many acres of park space, accidents and injuries are possible, although serious injuries are exceedingly rare. The H.Y.D.E Out participants are subject to the usual assortment of abrasions, cuts and sprain that active children experience.

Agreement, Waiver and Release

In consideration for being permitted by Cordova Recreation and Park District (CRPD) to participate in the above activity, I hereby waive, release, and discharge any and all claims for damages for personal injury, death, or property damage which may have, or which may hereafter accrue to me as a result of participation in said activity(ies). This release is intended to discharge in advance CRPD (its officers, employees, and agents) from any and all liability arising out of or connected in any way with my participation in said activity, though that liability may arise out of negligence or carelessness on the part of the persons or entities mentioned above. It is understood that this activity involves an element of risk and danger of accidents and knowing those risks I hereby assume those risks. It is further agreed that this waiver, release and assumption of risk is to be binding on my heirs and assigns. I agree to indemnify and to hold the above persons or entities free and harmless from any loss, liability, damage, cost, or expense which they may incur as a result of my death or any injury or property damage that I may sustain while participating in said activity.

PARENTAL CONSENT (by parent/guardian if applicant is under 18 years of age): I hereby consent that my son/daughter _____ participate in the above activity, and I hereby execute the above Agreement, Waiver, and Release on his/her behalf. I state that said minor is physically able to participate in said activity. I hereby agree to indemnify and hold persons and entities mentioned above free and harmless from any loss, liability, damage, cost or expense which they may incur as a result of the death or any injury or property damage that said minor may sustain while participating in said activity.

Photograph Note: By signing this waiver, I understand that CRPD staff may photograph me and/or my minor children and that the District may use such photographs to promote District programs now and in the future. I expressly allow, and hereby waive any objection to, CRPD photographing of me and/or my minor children when I and/or my minor children are participating in a CRPD recreation program. I understand that all photos will remain the property of Cordova Recreation and Park District.

I do not approve of having me and/or my minor child(ren) photographed by CRPD staff or its affiliates.
