Construction Project Updates:

Neil Orchard Senior Activities Center Ceramic Storage Project

This year the Cordova Recreation & Park District received a \$27,000 grant from the City of Rancho Cordova's Community Enhancement Fund to provide a new kiln, an accessible walkway, and a storage shed for the Neil Orchard Senior Activities Center Ceramics Programs. The project will be constructed with in-house labor and is expected to be complete by December 2018.



Rosemont Community Park Dugout Replacement Project

The Rosemont Dugouts Improvements Project was included in the Board-approved Fiscal Year 2018/19 budget. Rosemont Little League generously donated additional funding that allows both the dugout and backstop to be improved on the park's main field. The Board of Directors approved a construction contract for this work at their September Board meeting and the project is expected to be under construction in late fall.
