

Cordova Recreation & Park District Aquatic Facility Rules

We hope you make amazing memories here as you relax, laugh, and play.
Please follow the rules, be respectful to staff and patrons and have a wonderful time!

Entry

1. Every person who enters during Public Swim pays the entrance fee
2. Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult (age 16+)
3. Children not bathroom trained must wear swim diapers
4. Any person having an infectious or communicable disease is prohibited from using a public pool
5. Patrons suspected of being under the influence of drugs or alcohol shall be denied entry
6. Seating is available on a first come, first served basis
7. Life jackets must be Coast Guard approved and are only permitted in designated areas
8. Facility is not responsible for lost or stolen items
9. Prohibited items include:
 - GLASS
 - Pets
 - Water toys, inflatables, scuba masks, fins, snorkels and water balloons
 - EZ-Up Canopies, beach umbrellas and BBQs
 - Alcohol and drugs
 - Smoking (including vaping devices and all forms of tobacco)
 - Bicycles, skateboards, roller-skates, scooters and other wheeled transportation
 - Weapons
 - Gum, gummies (fruit snacks) and sunflower seeds
10. Coolers are allowed and will require a visual check upon entrance
11. Cake and cupcakes must be consumed in the grass area only

Cordova Recreation & Park District Cordova Community Pool Rules

1. Be considerate and respectful while enjoying the Cordova Community Pool
2. Children six (6) and under and non-swimmers must always be within arm's reach of an adult
3. No hypoxic (breath holding) activities
4. No running on the pool deck and within the zero-entry pool area
5. No shoulder-rides or horseplay
6. No playing in the locker rooms, showers, bleacher area, ADA lifts or diving blocks
7. No climbing on railings, ladders, fences, water features, lifeguard chairs and trees
8. No hanging onto or diving over the lane lines and ropes
9. No diving in shallow areas of the pool; diving is restricted to designated areas only
10. Lap lanes are for lap swimming only
11. Unauthorized training or coaching of any kind is strictly prohibited
12. Food and beverages must be consumed at least 6 feet away from the pool
13. Keep our facility beautiful by using the trash receptacles
14. Any activities judged as unsafe by CRPD staff will not be allowed

Diving Board Rules

1. Strong swimmers only
2. One person at a time; wait on the ground
3. Mount the board by using the ladder
4. One bounce only
5. Jump or dive straight off the board, facing the water
6. Prohibited entries include:
 - Handstands and cartwheels
 - Sitting take-offs
 - Twists, gainers and can-openers
 - Back dives, back flips and inward dives
 - Any entry deemed unsafe by CRPD staff
7. No hanging on the board
8. Exit the Dive Area immediately after diving
9. Goggles and life jackets are prohibited
10. Swimming is not allowed in the designated diving board area

Lap Lane Rules

1. Lap Lanes are for lap swimming only
2. Please circle-swim (staying on the right side of the center line)
3. Share the lanes
4. Slower swimmers move to the right lane(s)
5. No hanging on the ropes

Swim Attire Guidelines

The Cordova Recreation & Park District (CRPD) Swim Attire Guidelines have been established in order to ensure the cleanliness of the pool. This policy is intended to serve as a general guideline for patrons and CRPD staff. If possible, patrons should wear attire designed for water activities. Patrons should not wear clothing that is excessively heavy, excessively loose or made of absorbent material. Please always rinse off in the showers prior to entering the pool.

Patrons are encouraged to wear: swimsuits, swim or board shorts, rash guards, athletic shorts, sports bra, dry-fit shirts and clothing, water socks.

Patrons should NOT wear: sweatpants, transparent clothing, clothing previously worn during a workout, jeans or clothing with frayed edges, flotations that are not USA Coast Guard approved, shoes.

CRPD reserves the right to change rules as deemed necessary by staff.
