

# White Rock Splash Park FAQs

Session 2: 1 - 2:30 p.m. Session 3: 3 - 4:30 p.m.

# How many people are you allowing in?

The current capacity is 70 individuals. Staff will continuously monitor the number of persons in the Splash Park and will allow the next in line inside as space allows.

## Can I bring in outside food?

Yes, we allow outside food. However, we ask that you enjoy it with only those members of your household, 6 feet from other individuals and to please throw your trash away. We DO NOT allow glass containers at the park (neither inside White Rock Community Park or at the splash park area).

# Can I bring my own chairs?

Yes, we encourage patrons to bring their own chairs. There is minimal seating at the splash park area and tables and benches are first-come-first serve.

### How much does it cost?

It is free to enter the park; however, there is a \$1 slide fee per person, per session to ride the slides due to the OSHA requirements.

OSHA States: For the safety of all users, those wishing to ride the water slides need to meet minimum height requirements and purchase a wristband. State law requires that our lifeguards enforce height requirement rules. Wristbands help our lifeguards identify eligible riders. All other water features at the splash park are open to all users at no charge.

## How tall do you have to be to ride the slides?

Small Slide (Orange): Rider must be at least 42" or 3ft 6in Large Slide (Yellow): Rider must be at least 46" or 3ft 10in Height checks at entrance are measured without shoes. Children not tall enough for slides can enter for free and play in the spray areas

### May I host a party at the Splash Park?

We do offer private parties on Saturday and Sunday evenings for up to 70 people. For more information email <a href="mailto:rentals@crpd.com">rentals@crpd.com</a>.

We do not offer parties during public hours. We are a community splash park that is available for all patrons to enjoy. Please do not bring large groups during public hours.
